What to Look For	Catch & Coach	Celebrate What You See
A dragon slayer admits to a mistake	That took courage. Why do you think honesty was important here?	I'm proud of your honesty. You weakened Falsefire with that choice.
A dragon slayer tells the truth despite the consequences	You were honest, and I know that was hard. Why would dishonesty have been a bad choice here?	That took real honesty and courage. You weakened Falsefire with that choice.
You see that a dragon slayer hesitates and is tempted to lie...	Before you make a choice on what to do here, let's SLAY this moment. [Walk through the SLAY steps.]	Being honest can be really hard sometimes, but every honest choice helps weaken Falsefire and strengthen your true self.
A dragon slayer apologizes for lying to someone	How do you think the other person felt when you lied to them? How do you think being dishonest affects our relationships with others?	Being honest and apologizing shows real strength. I'm proud you didn't let Falsefire have power over you!
You are certain that a dragon slayer is being dishonest	Hmm...that doesn't sound quite right. Let's take a breath and then I want you to tell me the full truth.	Telling the truth can be hard, but I know you can do it. Falsefire is strong, but you are stronger.
